

2023 Make Smoking History WA Targa Cup Series Sporting Regulations

1. GENERAL

- 1.1 Each event in the 2023 Make Smoking History WA Targa Cup Series will be promoted and organised by Targa West Pty Ltd. Supplementary Regulations will be published for each event

2. SCHEDULE

- 2.1 The 2023 Make Smoking History WA Targa Cup Series will be conducted over the following events:

There is no confirmation on the type of events that Targa South West or Targa West will be run as at the 7/42/2022. The Regulations will be amended if necessary, when they are confirmed. If Targa West is run as a rally, then it could be possible to run a Rallysprint in conjunction at Ellenbrook, Malaga and the City.

3. VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY

- 3.1 The 2023 Make Smoking History WA Targa Cup Series will be open to vehicles complying with the current Motorsport Australia Tarmac Rally Technical Regulations – Modern, Motorsport Australia Tarmac Rally Technical Regulations – Classic, or the Targa Australia Technical Regulations as they are written on the 1st of January each year.

Note: Vehicles that are not eligible for the Make Smoking History WA Targa Cup ARE still able to compete in any of the individual events (eg Shannons Targa Rallysprints), subject to conforming to the event Supplementary Regulations.

- 3.2 The crew of any vehicle found to be not eligible during the series, will have all points removed from the series.

3.3 Vehicles shall be split into Categories as follows:

Modern	1st January 2008 up to 31st December 2023
Early Modern	1 st January 1986 up to 31 st December 2007
Late Classic	1 st January 1972 up to 31 st December 1985
Early Classic	1 st January 1947 up to 31 st December 1971

4. CREW

4.1 There is no requirement for the driver or the co-driver to be registered for the WA Targa Cup. Points will be awarded for all crew members in eligible cars.

4.2 At any time, the crew shall consist of only two persons who shall be nominated respectively as “driver” and “co driver”.

4.2.1 If one crew member retires or if a third or more persons are admitted on board (except if this is to replace a sick or injured co-driver) the car shall automatically be excluded from the points for that round.

4.2.2 For the purposes of point scoring, driver and co-driver shall be treated separately.

4.3 Points will only be allotted to residents Western Australia. If one member of the crew is not a resident of Western Australia, the other Western Australia crew member will receive points.

5. EVENT DURATION

5.1 Should an event counting towards any of the WA Targa Cup Series not be able to run in its entirety for any reason, the points shall be awarded on the basis of the established classification: full points if more than 50% of the scheduled number of special stages has been run; half points being awarded if between 25% and 50% of the number of special stages has been run; and no points will be awarded if less than 25% of the scheduled number of special stages has been run.

6. AWARDS

6.1 Points will be awarded for places first to twentieth for each Category for each Event as per the attached Addendum.

6.2 Points will be awarded in order of the finishing position of each Event. For the purpose of allocating points, the finishing positions of all ineligible competitors shall be disregarded. Competitors are to finish every Stage on an event to be eligible for Points.

6.3 All Events will count.

6.4 In the case of a tie, Category Awards positions shall be determined by the greater number of higher placings.

6.5 Awards will be presented to 1st in each Category as per Article 3, at the Make Smoking History Targa West Presentation Dinner, to be held in the Hyatt Ballroom on Sunday 11th September 2023.

6.6 **Other Awards** - The right to introduce other awards during the Series is reserved by Targa West Pty Ltd.
