

2024 Make Smoking History WA Tarmac Cup Series

Sporting Regulations

1. GENERAL

- 1.1 Each event in the 2024 Make Smoking History WA Tarmac Cup Series will be promoted and organised by Tarmac Events WA Pty Ltd. Supplementary Regulations will be published for each event

2. SCHEDULE

- 2.1 The 2024 Make Smoking History WA Tarmac Cup Series will be conducted over the following events:

If events that are not run they will be removed from the Tarmac Cup.

If events are not run in the planned format, the Factor may be downgraded

Competitors cannot enter Tarmac West and the Ellenbrook, Malaga and City Rallysprints as they run at the same time.

3. VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY

- 3.1 The 2024 Make Smoking History WA Tarmac Cup Series will be open to vehicles complying with the current AASA Technical Regulations and the Tarmac Events WA Technical Regulations.

Note: Vehicles that are not eligible for the Make Smoking History WA Tarmac Cup ARE still able to compete in any of the individual events (eg Shannons Tarmac Rallysprints), subject to conforming to the event Supplementary Regulations.

- 3.2 The crew of any vehicle found to be not eligible during the series, will have all points removed from the series.

3.3 Vehicles shall be split into Categories as follows:

Modern	1st January 2008 up to 31st December 2024
Early Modern	1 st January 1986 up to 31 st December 2007
Late Classic	1 st January 1972 up to 31 st December 1985
Early Classic	1 st January 1947 up to 31 st December 1971

4. CREW

4.1 There is no requirement for the driver or the co-driver to be registered for the WA Tarmac Cup. Points will be awarded for all crew members in eligible cars.

4.2 At any time, the crew shall consist of only two persons who shall be nominated respectively as “driver” and “co driver”.

4.2.1 If one crew member retires or if a third or more persons are admitted on board (except if this is to replace a sick or injured co-driver) the car shall automatically be excluded from the points for that round.

4.2.2 For the purposes of point scoring, driver and co-driver shall be treated separately.

4.3 Points will only be allotted to residents Western Australia. If one member of the crew is not a resident of Western Australia, the other Western Australia crew member will receive points.

5. EVENT DURATION

5.1 Should an event counting towards any of the WA Tarmac Cup Series not be able to run in its entirety for any reason, the points shall be awarded on the basis of the established classification: full points if more than 50% of the scheduled number of special stages has been run; half points being awarded if between 25% and 50% of the number of special stages has been run; and no points will be awarded if less than 25% of the scheduled number of special stages has been run.

6. AWARDS

6.1 Points will be awarded for places first to twentieth for each Category for each Event as per the attached Addendum.

6.2 Points will be awarded in order of the finishing position of each Event. For the purpose of allocating points, the finishing positions of all ineligible competitors shall be disregarded. Competitors are to finish every Stage on an event to be eligible for Points.

6.3 All Events will count.

6.4 In the case of a tie, Category Awards positions shall be determined by the greater number of higher placings.

6.5 Awards will be presented to 1st in each Category as per Article 3, at the Make Smoking History Tarmac West Presentation Dinner, to be held in the Hyatt Ballroom on Sunday 15th September 2024.

6.6 **Other Awards** - The right to introduce other awards during the Series is reserved by Tarmac Events WA Pty Ltd.
